Requirements: NC registered nurse (RN) License; NC driver's license, Current CPR certification desired.

Preferred Qualifications: Graduation from a four-year university with a B.S. Degree in Nursing which includes Public Health Nursing; or graduation from an accredited school of professional nursing and two years of professional nursing experience including one year in public health; or an equivalent combination of training and experience.

Duties: The clinic nurse is a highly visible representative of the health department. Provide clinic duties including but not limited to: giving immunizations and other injections, taking medical histories, checking vital signs, assisting provider with procedures, vision, hearing and developmental screening, anticipatory guidance, counseling and education. Ability to work with a wide range of people.

Hours are 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday-Friday. This position is full time. Occasional evening or weekend work for special projects or special situations (e.g. communicable disease outbreaks).
